1. Welcome and introductions

The Clerk and councillors welcomed the parishioners and Alison explained the function of the Group as a Working Group of the parish council.

2. Election of chairman and agreement of Terms of Reference

Robin Brook was elected Chairman. The draft Terms of Reference (TOR) were agreed with removal of reference to Vice Chairman, as second person felt to be unnecessary. Alison to amend TOR and add to next parish council agenda for ratification.

3. Consideration of work of the group

Various documents tabled of traffic management ideas from other counties/villages.

Issues identified by Group members as relevant for Marden parish –

- Speeding
- Lorries coming down Woodbine, particularly on Sundays and possibly S&A workers
- Foreign registration cars coming from Bodenham direction
- Parking on the road, particularly by the school
- Need for education of drivers re hazard awareness.

4. Next steps

Alison to find out if zig-zag lines outside school are possible without a Traffic Regulation Order (TRO).

Agreed that need to put something out to parishioners to identify what are the issues throughout the parish, so priorities can be identified and recommendations made to parish council.
