7.1 <u>Work done in January</u>: Cutting back trees and vegetation from by Laystone Bridge. <u>Work due in February</u>: Strim round grit bins and remove rubbish from inside as required; Check Drain Tops and Grips through parish (Small Ashes down to School House and all village roads, Burmarsh, Litmarsh, Sutton Lakes, The Vauld, Venns Green, The Vern), clear as required; Mow x1.

Drainage grant on offer again – quote from Lengthsman for ditching works on all roads in parish (clearance of drain tops, reinstatement of grips, digging out ditch where necessary), £3,807.50 and jetting/sucking of road drains all round parish, £18,384.50. Total - £22,192 +VAT.

- 7.2 Landowners of various PROW have addressed issues MR38, MR4A, MR29, MR45. Problem with MR19 and MR12 muddy areas filled with clay but then used by 4x4s and delivery vans, leading to ruts and muddy areas landowner will work on PROW when weather improves; issue about vehicles and mud also reported online; landowners would like signs to prevent people driving down PROW. MR22 meeting with S&A and some local horse riders to discuss problems with gate and marking of PROW with tape; S&A still having problem with walkers not keeping to line of PROW and allowing dogs off lead. Various landowners contacted re stiles and other problems.
- 7.7 The land owners for the area behind the carpark at the Minimarket have proposed that the parish council could rent the area for a nominal fee of £15 per calendar month. For that the council can use the land and create it into an area that the villagers can use. There would be one stipulation that the area cannot have playground equipment erected.
- 7.9 Refreshment budget for 100 people; includes sandwiches, crisps, scones with cream/butter and jam, cakes and biscuits, tea/coffee/squash, tableware £435. Plus donated strawberries/blueberries?

 Prizes (50p Jubilee commemorative coins in presentation card and Jubilee medallions), card and crayons for making crowns/notices etc. hand waving flags, bunting, First Aider £564. Will be asking for sponsorship for

most of these.

Budget total <u>with sponsorship</u> £830 approx. for 100 people, without sponsorship £998 approx. £1,245 approx. for 200 people without sponsorship.

Aim is to send invitation to every household, asking for numbers attending for catering, with draw for lucky numbered invitation. However unlikely that people will commit to this.

<u>Fundraising Group needs agreement on what numbers to cater for – Church Event last year had about 400 people.</u>
