Many thanks to all of you who have contacted me, as Ward Councillor, with concerns over the situation at Moreton Bridge.

I am very aware that the situation is appalling and causing serious inconvenience, particularly impacting those of you who use this important thoroughfare for travelling to or from work or school.

I am also aware that when we have heavy rain that the alternative Laystone Bridge is the first location to be rendered impassable by flooding.

It is vital that we carry out the necessary repairs as quickly as can be done – I have elevated this matter to the top tier of management, who have promised action and to keep me informed of all progress

Marden have arranged an emergency Parish Council meeting next Tuesday 3rd December which I shall attend, and report all details that I have to hand.

Moreton-on-Lugg – I am waiting to hear of any meeting – or perhaps a group which can be communicated to collectively.

It is important that everyone is fully informed and I promise you that I will do all that I can to bring this awful situation to the earliest conclusion.
